The 13th Annual Force Health Protection (FHP) Conference will take place August 7th through August 13th at the Phoenix Convention Center in Phoenix, Arizona. The FHP Conference is a venue dedicated to educating attendees about health promotion, disease and injury prevention, health risks from occupational and environmental health threats, as well as related preventive medicine and public health topics in garrison and deployed settings. The Office of Force Health Protection and Readiness will actively participate in this exchange of health care related information and strategies with officials from all levels of the government. “This is a unique opportunity to bring together senior leaders, providers and clinicians to discuss the issues that directly impact our Service members.
